DA LUCA PRESECCO

Located in the heart of Sicily, Da Luca was founded as a celebration of everything great about Sicilian wine. As the brand's popularity grew, the winemaking team took their flair for creativity to other regions of Italy renowned for high quality, authentically Italian wines. To create this wine, the winemaking team worked closely with small grower-producers in Treviso, known as the original Prosecco producing region. Color: Pale straw, clear, and bright. Bouquet: Clean and crisp with wonderful aromas of peach and apricot. Palate: Fresh, bright citrus flavors, balanced with stone fruit sweetness. Lingering on the palate with pineapple notes and a clean mouthwatering finish. Alc. 10.5%

BERINGER BOURBON BARREL CHARDONNAY WE91

This wine showcases a bouquet of ripe apricot, vanilla bean, and buttered toast. Creamy and mouth-coating, the palate evokes apple pie and vanilla ice cream with caramel coming through on the lingering finish. Beringer Bros. Chardonnay is picked at the peak of flavor development from top sites across California and fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks with 25% malolactic fermentation. 20% of the wine is aged for 60 days in second-pass charred American Oak barriques which previously held Bourbon.

ELOUAN PINOT NOIR

Rich, dark, and intense fruit flavors take top billing in this 2016 Elouan Pinot Noir, a wine that beautifully reflects the warm and dry growing season. Dark ruby in color, the wine powers up with aromatics of a plum pie, mixed-berry jam and smoky, game-bird characteristics that set the stage for flavors of cherry, blackberry, boysenberry, and smoked bacon. The balance is excellent, with solid structure, superb depth and concentration, rich tannins, and a nice smoky, earthy finish.

FRESCOBALDI NIPOZZANO JS93

Nipozzano 2015 has an intense ruby-red colour. The nose provides a pleasant combination of the clear notes of red berries and lightly toasted coffee, lending complexity to the wine before giving way to a fresh and spicy finish. In the mouth the wine is rich, characterised by the elegant density of the grapes and the mineral freshness of the finish that make it balanced and persistent. 13.0% alc.

RENATO RATTI MARCENASCO RP91 WE92 JS92 WS90

Marcenasco is a trademarked name that belongs to the Renato Ratti estate, but it also refers to a vineyard in the La Morra township. The 2014 Barolo Marcenasco offers dark and rich aromas of pressed rose with dark fruit, smoke and tar. The fruit almost appears to be on the ripe side, yet the wine also reveals the depth and the sophistication of aged Nebbiolo. In the mouth, Marcenasco is a bit thinner than your
